Berlin Woolwork*

Berlin Work was first introduced at the beginning of the 1800s and used mostly in furnishing.
It was primarily worked on canvas with wool thread. Traditional pieces were stitched using tent stitch.

This folio consists of a set of beautifully hand painted floral charts, along with pattern and history booklets. There is a sample included stitched on linen using DMC stranded thread and cross stitched.
